Why Use a Consent Agenda?

Consent agendas offer a practical solution for decision-makers who want to maximize every minute of a board meeting. The advantages are that boards can approve all actions with one single motion instead of making multiple motions. The agenda revolves around routine action items, which saves valuable time and provides expanded opportunities to engage in strategic discussions and action planning.

In order to make the consent agenda work well, all topics must be familiar, require no discussion, and involve no conflict. If a board member believes that an item in the consent agenda necessitates further discussion, they may make a motion to move the item from the consent agenda to the regular meeting agenda.

Common information in a consent agenda includes: approval of minutes from the previous meeting, presentation of information that requires no action, appointment schedules, updates to organizational information, action items discussed in detail previously and that wait for a final vote, and staff appointments requiring board confirmation. You may have other items on the agenda that are familiar, require no discussion, and involve no conflict.
