


CARES Act: Using the Funds



As federal money continues to be released, universities and colleges are looking for ways to put this money to use.

Under CRRSAA section 314(c), grant awards under these programs may be used to:

- 1. **Defray expenses** associated with coronavirus (including lost revenue, reimbursement for expenses already incurred, technology costs associated with a transition to distance education, faculty and staff trainings, and payroll)
- 2. Carry out student support activities authorized by the HEA that address needs related to coronavirus
