## Senate Ed Committee to discuss BEST bill on Thursday

Who: CASB members in Regions 3, 10, 11 and 12

What: Testimony on Senate Bill 16-72, concerning the Building Excellent Schools Today (BEST) program, which will be up for discussion in the Senate Education Committee. The bill, sponsored by Sen. Andy Kerr, proposes to increase the amount of money available annually to the BEST program with revenues earned from Public Schools Lands. Read about the legislation.

When: The Education Committee is scheduled to convene at 1:30 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 26, but the time may be delayed depending on business earlier in the day.
