Senate Ed Committee to discuss BEST bill on Thursday

Who: CASB Region 2 board members attending Day at the Capitol

What: Testimony on Senate Bill 16-72, concerning the Building Excellent Schools Today (BEST) program, which will be up for discussion in the Senate Education Committee. The bill, sponsored by Sen. Andy Kerr, proposes to increase the amount of money available annually to the BEST program with revenues earned from Public Schools Lands. Read about the legislation.
