We're half way through the 2015 legislative session and school finance decisions are just around the corner. Unfortunately, the prospect of buying down the negative factor is not something lawmakers are talking about.

The \$200 million buy down of the negative factor promised by Gov. Hickenlooper seems to have been forgotten. In fact, the legislature passed a motion to keep the negative factor flat.
