## New School Finance Proposal Gets First Hearing In Senate Education Committee

<u>SB 13-213</u>, Senator Johnston's new school finance bill, will be heard at a special session of the Senate Education Committee at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Old Supreme Court Chambers. Live audio will be available on the <u>Colorado General Assembly website</u>.

CASB has been actively engaged in the conversations leading up to the first draft of the bill, which was released just over a week ago. From the beginning, CASB has been fighting against creating "winners and losers" in the bill.

We have had some success, but there is still a lot of work to be done. Senator Johnston is often a hard sell. We will be at the table at tomorrow's hearing to share our concerns with the Education committee.

Our highest priorities are:

- 1. Inequities created by the elimination of the cost of living factor and other changes to per pupil funding calculation
- 2. Flow of ELL and at-risk dollars directly to building principals
- 3. State-local funding stabilization, which negatively impacts 27 districts
- 4. Special education funding changes
- 5. Charter school funding changes
