Legislative Alert: April 30, 2015



URGENT: Take action to free up dollars for schools

House Bill 1389 was just introduced to designate the hospital provider fee as an "enterprise" under TABOR. If approved, the bill would free up to approximately \$689 million general fund dollars in future years to be spent on public education and other critical public services. This means there will still be taxpayer refunds issued next year.

The hospital provider fee is not a tax and the fees are paid by hospitals so they can access federal matching funds.
